Directions

Joint Application: Substrates to be clean of oil, dirt, contaminants and old sealant. Mask joint edges. Cut nozzle end at 45° angle to the desired opening. Cut end from cylinder bung leaving the thread. Screw nozzle to bung thread. Place in cylinder applicator gun. Insert nozzle into joint, squeeze trigger and push gun in a forward direction – never pull backwards as air may be trapped in joint preventing a good seal. Remove masking before skinning. **Priming:** Prime porous concrete, timber, brick and stone with Sabre Primer PX. Prime critical nonporous surfaces, i.e. hi-nickel, stainless steel or bronze, with Sabre Surface Activator.

Painting: SabreBond SMP45 is suitable for most paints - test for compatibility. For best paint bond, apply promptly after sealant cure.
